Religious Education - To Know You More Clearly Branch 5 – To the Ends of the Earth

Literacy & Phonics

Talk Through Stories – Supertato, Aliens Love Underpants & On the Way Home. Daily ReadWriteInc phonics sessions. Story & rhyme times. Shared reading, fiction & non-fiction. Nursery Rhymes. Model writing daily. Enjoy independently exploring books. Retell stories, using story phrases. Recognise some written names. Read some phonically decodable words. Form some letters correctly. Create drawings & write words & stories in response to experiences. Link sounds to letters & write recognisable letters e.g. their name or a label.

Mathematics

Number rhymes. Number Blocks.
Explore composition of numbers within 1 0and the pairs of numbers that make a larger number, including doubles. Explore more than, fewer than, less than and equal to. Order numbers to 10 and understand that each number is one more than the one before. Sort objects according to different criteria and look at even and odd numbers. Explore & add to repeating patterns. Find the longer or shorter, heavier or lighter of two items. Using a variety of shapes, make models of increasing complexity. Begin to measure with timers and calendars. Use tens frames to organise countina.

Communication & Language

R.E. Weather & calendar. Nursery Rhymes. Talk
Through Stories – Supertato, Aliens Love
Underpants & On the Way Home. Charanga –
music activities. Key worker groups – stories &
rhymes. Story times. Vocabulary related to
plant growth, magnets, floating & sinking & the
beach. Talk & listen to each other's
experiences and ideas, developing
conversations. Begin to use & understand
sentences that are more complex. Following
instructions in a variety of activities.

Physical Development

P.E. Negotiate space successfully when playing, avoiding obstacles. Experiment with different ways of moving, testing out ideas and adapting movements. Shows increasing control over an object in pushing, throwing, kicking or catching. Constructing with large blocks & crates. Continue to develop skills to use equipment safely & pencils effectively. Form recognisable letters independently, most of which are correctly formed. Shows some understanding that good practices with regard to exercise, eating, drinking water & hygiene can contribute to good health...

Expressive Arts & Design

Nursery Rhymes. Charanga – Big Bear Funk. Join in singing songs. Explore musical instruments. Experiment with different ways of moving to music. Copy clapping a rhythm. Transient art. Sketching & printing. Explore texture & colours. Play cooperatively, to develop a storyline based on stories & own experiences. Represent ideas through art, role-play & stories.

Non-fiction information about plants, magnets, floating & sinking. Trip to a church and to the beach – talk about our experience, what we see and learn. Use Bee Bot & Coding Critters – directing around a route.

Continue to discuss school rules. Continue to develop friendships with other children & begin to understand different points of view & play together cooperatively. Understand that some actions & words can hurt others' feelings. Talk about their own & others' feelings. Practice skills of assertion, compromise & negotiation. Enjoy taking part in daily tasks. Confidently choose resources & persevere with their chosen activity. Begin to adapt behaviour in different social situations.
